Cowper/Cowdrey Trophy

As advised previously the MCC has sponsored an exquisite trophy for the match to be played between the two MCCs in association with each Ashes Test. The trophy will shortly be on display in the Members' Pavilion where it will remain regardless of the outcome of each match; just as with the famous urn residing at Lord's.

The match was part of a series of contests against the Marylebone Cricket Club, a reciprocal club of the MCC. A full report of the Marylebone matches in cricket, golf, and real tennis is written-up in the latest MCC News magazine.

After four rubbers the score was 2 all and the match could have gone either way but Melbourne moved away winning the last two rubbers easily. Doubtless Lord's will do their best to ensure their defeat is avenged on their home court in August 2012, coinciding with the Olympic Games in London.
