Look at experiencing the weekend and staying at Romsey with the Hobartians and have a great night there. Dinner and breakfast will be provided. Romsey is only about 45 minutes from Richmond. Mike Carroll will be hosting this event, so let him know you can play.

November 23<sup>rd</sup> Sunday is our annual match against Ballarat, again at Romsey. This is a great day and a good way to end the year just prior to the Christmas break.

20<sup>th</sup> July saw MCCRTS take on RMTC at Richmond, with 7 players representing MCCRTS, we finished the day 7 matches each but MCCRTS won by one game, 81 to 80 games. Interesting that 5 of the RMTC players are also MCCRTS members. All players had a win with Calum Munro and Will Fowles the premier performers.

21<sup>st</sup> September saw MCCRTS field a side to play Sydney TC at the last minute. STC were to play RMTC over 2 days for the Barry Toates Trophy but in the last few days, RMTC notified STC they could not field a side for Sunday. We had 8 players coming along to play handicap doubles, including a new member Gilliam Patmore playing her first match. STC ended up winning 6/4 but it came down to the last match played with MCCRTS going down 6/5 in the third set (best of 3). Paul Wheeler was the best performer for MCCRTS.
